# **The Purpose of Government's Existence**

## **1. Who made the Government?**

“WE THE PEOPLE” made the Government.

## **2. Who are “We The People”?**

“WE THE PEOPLE” are the Sovereign Individuals who are citizens of the United States of America.

## **3. What do we mean when we say that “WE THE PEOPLE” are the Sovereign Individuals?**

When we say that "WE THE PEOPLE" are the Sovereign Individuals we mean that Each Individual is above all creatures and creations of Government. The sovereignty of the people is the belief that the legitimacy of the state is created by the will or consent of its people, who are the source of every political power

## **4. Why did “WE THE PEOPLE” make Government?**

“WE THE PEOPLE” instituted Government to secure the unalienable Rights, endowed by our Creator, that among these, are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness.

## **5. What does unalienable Rights mean?**

Unalienable Rights are Not to be separated, given away, or taken away; they are the absolute rights of sovereign individuals. They may be resolved into the right of personal security, the right of personal liberty, and the right to acquire and enjoy property. These rights are declared to be natural, inherent, and unalienable.

## **6. What must Government do to gain the happiness of heaven?**

To gain the happiness of Heaven & Earth the Government must know, love, serve and secure the unalienable Rights of “WE THE PEOPLE” in this world.

## **7. Where does Government find the chief truths taught by “WE THE PEOPLE”?**

Government finds the chief truths taught by “WE THE PEOPLE” in the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States of America.

## **8. What is the Constitution?**

The CONSTITUTION is a Charter – the written instrument agreed upon by “We the People”. This instrument creates the government. Without a constitution, government shall not exist. It is the absolute rule of action and decision for all departments and officers of the government in respect to all the points covered by it. The Constitution must control the government until it shall be changed by the authority which established it. That authority is “We the People”. Any act or ordinance of any such department or officer which is in opposition of the Constitution is null and void. Furthermore, it is the duty of “We the People” to ignore or resist any such act or ordinance.

## **9. From whom does Government learn to know, love, and serve “WE THE PEOPLE”?**

Government, which means any such department or officer, learns to know, love, and serve “WE THE PEOPLE” by a strict adherence to the Constitution and from an understanding and reverence of The Declaration of Independence. It is the Sons & Daughters of “WE THE PEOPLE”, who control the Government through constant reminder of the Right of the People to alter or to abolish Government, and to institute new Government, laying its foundations on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to affect their Safety and Happiness. The Declaration of Independence is the foundation document of the Sovereign American Citizen – the true American Spirit.

## **10. What happens if the government fails to secure the unalienable Rights of “WE THE PEOPLE” in this world?**

If the government fails to secure the unalienable Rights of “WE THE PEOPLE” in this world either by not exercising its power or exceeding the limits of its authority; it violates the charter that created it and in doing so negates itself. In other words, it ceases to exist. If the charter is violated, logic tells us that all previous agreements cease to lawfully exist as well.

## **11. Say the "WE THE PEOPLE" Creed.**

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these, are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness. That, to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed, that, whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundations on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to affect their Safety and Happiness

**The Baltimore Catechism** was the de facto standard Catholic school text in the United States from 1885 to the late 1960s. It was the first such catechism written for Catholics in North America. **The Newest Baltimore Catechism©2012** is not a religious text and it should be taught in all schools in these United States. Mandatory testing and a demonstrated high level of competency should also be required of all persons seeking public office and public service jobs.
